How to register with us

We welcome new patients to Haxby Group.

You can register with us at any surgery if you live within our practice boundary. Please visit our website

www.haxbygroupscarborough.nhs.uk to view our boundary map on our 'New Patients' page.

You will be allocated a named accountable GP responsible for your overall care. Your named GP may not always be available. You can request a specific GP though this may mean a longer wait for an appointment.



Online - visit www.haxbygroupscarborough.nhs.uk and visit the “New Patients” page. Standard registration at our practice does not require any form of identification.



In person - call into the surgery and our Patient Services Team will help you to register.

Please note the requirement for photo identification if you wish to register for online services, which we would recommend.

How to request an appointment



Online - you can request or cancel an appointment online at www.haxbygroupscarborough.nhs.uk. This facility is available from 7am - 6.30 pm Monday to Friday (6pm-6.30pm routine and admin requests only)



Telephone - contact us between 8am and 6.30pm on **01723 360835** (6pm-6.30pm routine and admin requests only)



In person - an appointment request can be made in person at the surgery - opening times are on Page 12.

Once we close, if you need urgent same day care, please contact NHS 111 for out-of-hours services.

ALL appointment requests are seen by a senior clinician who makes a clinical decision around the time frames and clinicians required for each individual based on information given. It is important to provide as much information as possible.

Types of appointment

You may be offered different types of appointment depending on your needs, such as:

- Face to face GP appointment - both urgent and routine
- Face to face appointment with another member of our clinical team - both urgent and routine
- Telephone call from our clinical team

Get online

At www.haxbygroupscarborough.nhs.uk you can carry out a number of requests or ask a general question. ALL requests are dealt with equitably and any online requests go through the same systems, and at the same pace, as those made on the phone or in person.

When the surgery is closed

If you need medical advice or care when the surgery is closed, you can contact:

- NHS 111 by calling 111 for free from landlines or mobiles or by visiting 111.nhs.uk
- Your local community pharmacist

Community pharmacists are able to give you free health advice at any time. Many pharmacies operate extended hours. You can self-refer for common conditions such as sore throat, earache and sinusitis under the Pharmacy First scheme.

In a medical emergency, you MUST call 999.

Home Visits

If you feel too ill to come to the surgery or are unable to leave your home for medical reasons, please let us know before 10:30am, where possible, through any of the appointment pathways. A clinician may telephone you in the first instance. Please note that home visits can only be allocated to patients who are assessed as housebound.

How to get a test result




Online - you can view your test results online via the NHS App.




Telephone - please telephone us on 01723 360835 and select the test results option in between the hours of **2pm and 6pm Monday-Friday**. Please leave 3-5 working days between the test and giving us a call.


How to order a prescription

Please order repeat prescriptions in plenty of time when going away or prior to bank holidays. Please allow a minimum of 3-5 full working days before collection and longer for bank holidays.

 **NHS App** - If you sign up to the NHS App via your computer, tablet or mobile phone, you can order your repeat prescriptions via this method.

 **Online** - please visit www.haxbygroupscarborough.nhs.uk and go to our Prescriptions page

 **In person** - please drop a note into our surgery

 **By post** - you can request a repeat prescription by post. Please enclose a stamped addressed envelope for its return if you have not nominated a pharmacy for your prescription.

NHS App

Download the NHS App to link to your GP surgery. Once verified, you can access aspects of your medical record including repeat prescriptions. To access, please search for NHS App online, on the Apple App Store or on Google Play to find out more.

NHS services

Our teams provide the full range of NHS care, plus some specialist services, including:

- Annual flu vaccinations
- Anticoagulation monitoring
- Blood Pressure Monitoring - initially at the BP Pod in Reception
- Cervical smears
- Childhood immunisations
- Chronic disease management
- ECG - heart monitoring
- Foreign travel advice - please note we do not routinely offer non-NHS vaccines and if we are able a fee will apply.
- Minor illness
- Joint injections
- New patient and well person checks at patient request
- First Contact Physiotherapy
- Women's services - family planning and contraception
- Copies of patient records
- Phlebotomy (blood taking) service
- Social Prescribing

Non-NHS services

We offer a range of non-NHS services for which a fee may be charged. These include:

- Medical examinations for driving or other occupational reasons
- Forms and letters requiring medical opinion or medical details
- Insurance reports

We are an Advanced Teaching Practice, GP training provider and part of the Hull York Medical School.

To help with this training, you may be asked to have a student present during your consultation. You can of course decline this request.

Personal information

Patient information is stored electronically in a secure and confidential manner, and we comply with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

As a patient, you have access to your medical record through your online account, via the NHS App or by making a Subject Access Request for your full medical record.

Our privacy notice is displayed in our surgery and on our website.
